

Arrow hitting person behind targets	Dangerous	Possible	All	Shooting range will be set out clearly according to GNAS guidelines.
Novice not shooting at target	Dangerous	Possible	Waiting archers and spectators	Strict supervision and clear safety brief prior to issuing equipment by GNAS Archery Leader.
Arrow fired inappropriately	Very Dangerous	Possible	All	Full safety brief given prior to issuing equipment by GNAS Archery Leader. Strict supervision throughout.
Equipment failure in use	Dangerous	Improbable	Archer	All equipment thoroughly checked prior to use by GNAS Archery Leader
Overdrawn arrow injuring archer	Dangerous	Possible	Archer	Correct arrow selection for each archer by trained staff.
Falling onto shot arrow	Dangerous	Possible	Archers collecting arrows from targets	Full safety brief given to GNAS guidelines prior to collection by GNAS Archery Leader.
Arrow drawn into archers	Dangerous	Possible	Archers collecting arrows from targets	Full safety brief given to GNAS guidelines prior to collection by GNAS Archery Leader.
Misuse of equipment	Dangerous	Possible	All	All archers and equipment will be kept under close supervision by GNAS Archery Leader. All incidences of misuse will result in offending person being removed from the activity.
