

Archery Technical Data Sheet

Archery is a projectile sport. Injury or even death can result unless all safety instructions are followed and all safety equipment provided is worn properly.

All archery sessions will be supervised by a Grand National Archery Society (GNAS) Archery Leader (GNAS AL). The Archery Leader will supervise archers whilst shooting, all groups must ensure that they have staff present to supervise those waiting to shoot.

Archery ranges will be set out in accordance with GNAS guidelines as follows:

Indoor

Length of the range will vary, depending on the ability of each group, but will be between 8 and 15 yards.

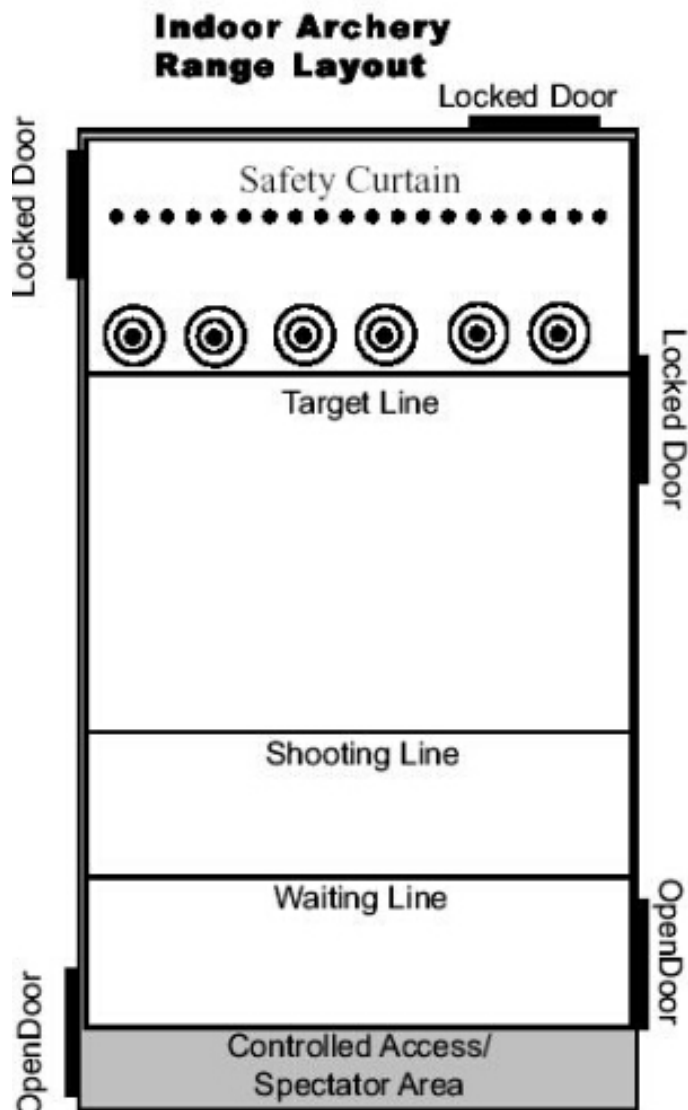
The range will be set out to avoid the possibility of the public gaining access to it via alternative entrances.

Archery in progress signs will be clearly placed on all access doors to the range.

Targets will be placed between 1 and 2 yards from an impenetrable barrier (i.e. wall); with backstop netting between targets and barrier.

A shooting line will be clearly marked and set up.

A waiting line 5 yards behind the shooting line will be clearly marked and set up.



OUTDOOR

Ranges will ideally be set up with the shooting direction towards an impenetrable barrier (i.e. wall).

Length of the range will vary, depending on the ability of each group, but will be between 8 and 15 yards.

A Overshoot Boundary Line will be established behind the target line, which will be roped off and clearly marked.

The range will be set out to avoid the possibility of the public gaining access to it via alternative entrances. **Archery in progress** signs will be clearly placed on all access points to the range.

Targets will be placed between 1 and 2 yards in front of backstop netting, which will be extended down the sides towards the shooting line.

A shooting line will be clearly marked and set up.

A waiting line 5 yards behind the shooting line will be clearly marked and set up.

A spectator line 5 yards behind the waiting line will be clearly marked and set up.
